# **The Unpleasant Truth**

Paul Piscator, NRA Firearms Training Instructor, formally Civilian & Law Enforcement Smith & Wesson Instructor, formally a Stress Fire Lethal Force Instructor

"The greatest enemy of knowledge is not ignorance, but the illusion of knowledge." (Daniel Boorstin) "It's not what you once did, it's what you can do now. On demand." As I watch people shoot at the range, as well as what I see in many requalification courses for law enforcement personnel, I ask myself, are we training for the fight or is it training for self-admiration or self-image and for law enforcement eligibility qualification requirements. The one who determines your fate is what will get you through the lethal encounter. If we look at the vast majority of shootings, they happen at close distances. In retrospect look back at the shootings which take place on our streets. If you have a good shooting stance, you are not shooting fast enough, nor moving fast enough, nor using other force-on-force tactics. Defensive shooting for your life is fast moving. This is not the time for choreography because you will fail. Training for life encounters is how to decide among options under stress.

As we stand stationary shooting, conforming to moral and ethical principles, at the 25' line we exhibit like a row of ducks in a shooting gallery. Our target(s) are stationary as we unshackle those rounds. After you have annihilated your target you stand there proudly thinking to yourself, dam it I am good. Unfortunately, this is not the world as it exists under assault. Involved shootings are fluid situations which most often involve the attacker(s) taking aggressive steps, making advances and progressing to control. Most importantly, you need to be able to shoot accurately while moving yourself and responding to a moving threat. Ask yourself are you capable of being able to shoot accurately while in a mobile environment. Are you able to perform with ability, efficiency, and competency shooting one handed while controlling love one(s) with your support hand in a fluid environment? Do you have the capabilities to control (stopping) the threat(s) without error in action and judgement and not taking an innocent's life? The result will be determined by you and you alone.

The absence of challenges can reinforce your belief that your perception, is indeed conformity with fact and reality. If no challenge is presented, you will continue using the sum of what is known without consideration for its defect or fallacy. Illusory capabilities are infectious. It is not always easy to rid the perceived capabilities from reality and never, never measure your success by the outcome. We must acknowledge the susceptible to illusory truths. I have witness this when training individuals, if this goes unchecked it can be risky, unsafe, and perilous. The belief in one's self powers, abilities, self-confidence, self-reliance, self-assurance, and freedom from doubt is a belief very dangerous/harmful influence characterized by mortiferous confidence.

Lots of things are more important than marksmanship when defending oneself and love ones. You must put the threat at a tactical disadvantage, be capable of functioning under stress, shoot from impossible difficult positions, identify threat(s) in dim light and communicate to others under your responsibility. "We do not rise to the level of our expectations. We fall to the level of our training." (Greek philosopher – Archilochus). Keep in mind having confidence but with no skill to back it up makes you a detriment to yourself and to those for whom you may be responsible. Our confidence influences our judgments. You cannot get stronger if you never leave your comfort zone. We are prone to stay inside the limits of what we consider our comfort zone. Once pushed outside those limits, beyond the confines we have earned that real-estate, and the right to be comfortable in it, don't pass up the opportunity to further develop your abilities. Developing your capabilities is a journey, not a destination. Today we live in a world that demands either you control the threat, or the threat controls you. Accept the fact, it could happen at any moment. "There is a difference between interest and commitment. When you are interested in something, you do it when it is convenient. When you are committed, you accept no excuses...only results" (Kenneth Blanchard). Remember it's your choice! Remember, it's your choice!

#### **HSA TRAP REPORT**

We continue to shoot trap on Tuesday mornings and Thursday evenings. We start shooting on Tuesdays at 9 AM and on Thursdays at 5 PM and trap shooting is open to both men and women. You do not have to be a club member to participate in our organized trap shoots on Tuesday and Thursday. Please try and arrive a little early to sign up. We comply with social distancing rules, stay outside as much as possible, and the clubhouse is open for restroom use. Due to both our lower winter turn-out and the Covid concerns, we usually end up shooting between three and five squads and shoot for about an hour and a half each day.

For any new shooters, here are some points to keep in mind. All attendees must observe all club/gun safety rules at all times, and must also read and abide by the trap rules which are posted and available at the club. For those of you who haven't shot trap before bring the following: a shotgun (preferably 12 gauge or 20 gauge (no short barrel or pistol grip), eye protection, hearing protection, shells (25 rounds per squad you sign up for with #7 1/2 or #8 size shot). Also recommended are a billed cap or visor, a shooting vest or pouch for holding your ammunition, and shooting gloves if desired. You can sign up for one squad at a time and re -sign up for another as soon as you finish shooting the squad you were on. New shooters must watch at least one squad shoot before shooting and we will have a regular shooter stand behind you for your first squad shooting both for safety and to show you our local rules. Also, new shooters: prior to shooting we recommend that you "pattern your shotgun". This is to show you where your gun actually shoots based on gun fit, your aim, and the gun's characteristics and is invaluable to help you get started hitting "birds". Come down ½ hr. early, and bring some extra shells, if you'd like help patterning your shotgun. This can be done here at the club on the pistol range and there are members who are willing to accompany and assist you in doing this.

Finally, we throw out a "green" bird randomly once each squad and if broken by the shooter who gets it thrown on their turn, they win a free round. Each round of 25 shots (5 shots from each of 5 stations) costs \$4.00 for HSA members and \$5.00 for guests. Please come out and shoot with us and feel free to contact me with any guestions.
