GEYER'S CORNER

With all the Civil War re-enactments being shown on TV you are bound to see some glitches in their handling of their rifles. One thing, in particular, is when someone shoots a flintlock or a muzzleloader with the cap rather than flint, there is almost always an instinct of recoil due to the rifleman failing to stay on the stock and thus off the target. This is quite common, even with modern guns and ammo. We (and I don't claim to be an exception) are preparing for the shot and flinch, even though it may be slight. I would venture to say we ALL do it sometime. If you doubt my word, please allow me to load your firearm a few times while you shoot. This is the huge difference between an excellent shooter and a fair shooter. When you have trained yourself to stay on target when that gun goes boom! Assured you are on the way to excellence with whatever firearm you choose.

There are ways to train for this problem. Easy with a revolver. Simply load three or four live rounds and the rest of the cylinder with fired cases. By the way, for years I did a lot of dry-firing, rapid fire style, just for speed. I did not always use empties. Then I chanced upon an excellent book written by a S&W gunsmith; one of the most important items he stressed, among DON'T TRUST ANY SAFETY, was that you should **not** dry fire without empties or snap-caps! Since I read that, I've stuck with his advice. Anyway, the first time you try this, you may be a bit surprised to see that muzzle will drop a bit and if you are right-handed, it may be a bit to the left also. Continued on page 4.....

TRAP REPORT

Welcome to all trap shooters. Trap participation has been improving continuously since the easing of Covid restrictions. Out biggest issue has been the recent hot weather on shooting days that has put a little damper on attendance, but we continue to shoot and have a great core of regular shooters in addition to some new shooter who have joined us. We also have a new official trap representative to the HSA BOD and his name is Mike Semo.

Trap shooting is a great sport and we have both male and female participants who range in age from juniors to a shooter in his 90's. We stress safety and safe gun handling at all times to preserve everyone's fun. We shoot trap on Tuesday mornings and Thursday evenings. We start shooting on Tuesdays at 9 AM and on Thursdays at 5 PM and trap shooting is open to both men and women. Please try and arrive at least 15 minutes early to sign up and you do not have to be a club member to participate in these organized trap shoots. Based on the number of shooters who show up, we are now shooting for about 1½ hours each day and will shoot from our start time until the last shooter there has shot.

For any new shooters, here are some points to keep in mind.

All attendees must observe all club/gun safety rules at all times, and must also read and abide by the trap rules which are posted and available at the club.

For those of you who haven't shot trap before bring the following: shotgun (preferably 12 gauge or 20 gauge (no short barrel or pistol grip), eye protection, hearing protection, shells (25 rounds per squad you sign up for with #7 ½ or #8 size shot).

Also recommended are a billed cap or visor, a shooting vest or pouch for holding your ammunition, and shooting gloves if desired.

You can sign up for one squad at a time and re-sign up for another as soon as you finish shooting the squad you were on.

New shooters must watch at least one squad shoot before shooting and we will have a regular shooter stand behind you for your first squad shooting both for safety and to show you our local rules.

Also, new shooters: prior to shooting we recommend that you "pattern your shotgun". This is to show you where your gun actually shoots based on gun fit, your aim, and the gun's characteristics and is invaluable to help you get started hitting "birds". Come down ½ hr. early, and bring some extra shells, if you'd like help patterning your shotgun. This can be done here at the club on the pistol range and there are members who are willing to accompany and assist you in doing this.

Finally, we throw out a "green" bird randomly once each squad and if broken by the shooter who gets it thrown on their turn, they win a free round. Each round of 25 shots costs \$4.00 for HSA members and \$5.00 for guests.

Continued from page 1......This is an indication of a slight flinch; if the barrel goes up that means the shooter is pushing against the grips. Years ago, my shooting buddy, Ron Scheier. and I would place a dime on our front sight of the revolver while we dry fired. Now and then we could keep that dime on the sight when our hammer fell. No big deal, but it was a training aid to follow through.

If you are an auto shooter; just put a round or two of dummies in the magazine and remember that they should be marked. Somehow, they must be loaded properly to duplicate a live round so they feed properly when the other rounds go boom! It is also good practice for that surprise malfunction that you will get eventually. This is good practice for action shooting when you must clear your faulty round. Remember, practice for the potential unusual things that will occur. That guy "Murphy" is still hanging around and guns clubs are one of his haunts!
