I'm not saying I originated the phrase "If you like a particular item, whether it be in the gun line, fishing lures....special outdoor gear,,, buy ANOTHER.....because sooner or later that wonderful item will not be available" An example; Back in 1963 (before most of you were driving) a gun expert, Lee Jurras developed a new Hi performance cartridge for the .38 Special....called it Super-Vel. At the time I was into re-loading pretty heavy....some for Mass. State Police....and I chanced to see and buy some of these new empties....I figgers...hey, that brass gotta be pretty top stuff if it's developed to take on Hi velocity ...and I latched onto a hefty batch. Now, I've been shooting .38's in the league (and others) Allentown, Guthsville...Unami using THAT batch....they are now starting to show cracks now and then...but I sure got money's worth......NOW I see super-vel is coming back....sorry to say I didn't maintain solid records of how many loads I got....but they sure beat any of the others.
