HSA Trap Report

We have both male and female participants from juniors through "ancients". We stress safety and safe gun handling at all times and we shoot trap on Tuesday mornings starting at 9:00 am, and Thursday evenings starting at 5 PM. Please try and arrive at least 15 minutes early to sign up and you do not have to be a club member to participate in these or-Each relay of 25 shots costs ganized trap shoots. \$5.00 for HSA members and \$6.00 for guests. throw out a "green" bird randomly once each relay and if broken by the shooter who gets it thrown on their turn, they win a free round. Based on the number of shooters who show up, we are now shooting for about $1\frac{1}{2}$ hours each day and will shoot from our start time until the last shooter there has shot. New shooters must watch at least one squad shoot before shooting and we will have a regular shooter stand behind you for your first squad shooting both for safety and to show you our local rules. We offer donuts and coffee and the clubhouse is open for the restrooms. Here's a link to review firearm safety on the trap field: https://www.youtube.com/watch? v=2PIKhjftTI8

Trap, skeet, and sporting clays are all in the "clay" sports family. HSA belongs to the NSSA-NSCA organization that represents all three of these endeavors. This month and in following months I will reprint a couple "pointers" presented by them to help improve one's shooting.

** You Never Have to Recover From a Good Start by Todd Bender

It is very common for shooters to have poor setup foot position, hold points, etc. Poor setup is the tip of the iceberg, and when that, at times, is associated with poor look points or eye placement, you have big problems. If you do not visually acquire a target quickly enough, or a target beats you because of a poor hold point, every subsequent move you make is a recovery. Even if your initial physical starting points are good, if you are not mentally concentrated and focused visually, then your physical moves after the target leaves the window are recoveries. Most shots made by most shooters are recoveries from poor starts and/or poor preparation. But if you put all the parts together - good physical setup, solid mental concentration and good visual focus - you'll get off to a good start you won't have to recover from.

** Review Your Misses by Paul Giambrone III

When you've missed a target, it can help to do a quick review of the shot. Analyze your mental execution to get your answer. Guess what — sometimes we can do everything we wanted to do mentally and still miss the shot (not often, but it happens). When this happens, there is usually a technique failure. The most common one is the shooter lifting their head just enough to cause the miss. Everything looked correct and felt right, but that target didn't break. When this happens, I simply execute all of my mental steps on the next shot and make sure my head stays firmly down on the qun.
