
Amber and Jon are closing out the first season of the BB gun program and have done a great job and their first banquet is scheduled as well.

#### LEHIGH VALLEY POLICE REVOLVER LEAGUE

LVPRL is now in the third month of it's 87<sup>th</sup> consecutive bullseye pistol shooting year. We are the oldest continuously operating bullseye pistol league in the country! Our league hours are 5pm to 9pm every Wednesday. New shooters are always welcome. An experienced league member will stay with new shooters on the line until all range commands and safety practices are understood and followed.



Currently we have about 40 members (men and women) and there is no deadline for a joining date. Prospective HSA members can use LVPRL to fulfill an activity participation requirement as noted on the membership paperwork.

Safety is of prime importance in our league. All range activities are under the direction and command of our experienced range officers. All shooting is at 25 yards and each relay is comprised of slow, timed and rapid fire. Slow fire is 10 shots in 5 minutes, timed fire is two five shot strings of 20 seconds each, and rapid fire is two five shot strings of 10 seconds each.

We require new shooters to use a .22 caliber pistol until they show proficiency and safe gun handling. Then and only then can center fire pistols be used. Shooters can shoot one or two handed and can shoot as an individual or as an assigned team member. Scores can be fired for practice only or count for record towards end of season trophies. Record scores must be fired before practice rounds if both are done on the same evening. If someone does not have a .22 pistol and wishes to try out the league, a member will allow that person to temporarily use his .22.

The application is on the website and it is \$10.00 to join with one gun an additional gun is \$2.50 if approved for center fire. You can shoot as an individual or team or both. It costs \$3.00 for the building fund which helps HSA with the cost of heat and \$3.00 per relay. Of course with the cost of your gun and ammo it is still an affordable night out folks.

A league season starts in January and ends in October but from October to December there is practice league which is open at the same time Wednesday nights except holidays. No rest for the members because they need to keep in practice. But I thought I saw a lot of socializing going on too. There is a catered banquet at the clubhouse in November which is a very fun event.

The maximum score is 300 and recently some shooters have come very close, shooting well into the 290's! A red dot scope is helpful. Don't be intimidated because beginners are usually surprised at how good they are when they start.
